PPP Application Window Opening Monday Morning

Congress has passed and President Trump has signed a relief bill that replenishes the Paycheck Protection Program. SBA Director Jovita Carranza announced that applications will resume being taken Monday, April 27 at 9:30 am. LISC Small Business Loans

LISC, through a partnership with State Farm, is providing loan interest loans of between \$75,000 to \$500,00 to small businesses through their Rapid Relief and Resiliency Fund. The program allows LISC to make loans similar to banks but with more flexible credit standards to reach businesses that might not qualify for conventional loans. The interest rate for the first 12 months is 2%. More information here.
