Reminder: Taxpayers Should File by July 15 Tax Deadline

The Department of the Treasury and IRS <u>announced</u> that the tax filing and payment deadline of July 15 will not be postponed. Individual taxpayers unable to meet the July 15 due date can request an automatic extension of time to file until Oct. 15 but must proactively do so. Due to COVID-19, the original filing deadline and tax payment due date for 2019 was postponed from April 15 to July 15.

Illinois Rebuild Distressed Communities Program - Applications Due July 7

The \$25 million Rebuild Distressed Communities program will reimburse the costs to repair structural damages, including repairs to storefronts and entrances, improving electrical systems, and restoring exterior work for businesses damaged in recent civil unrest. Organizations interested in applying to administer Distressed Capital Program grants must apply by July 7th. Reminder: Illinois Business Interruption Grant First Round Applications Due July 7 The state of Illinois is now accepting applications for the first round of its Business Interruption Grant (BIG) program. The program will allocate \$60 million in grants in this first round to bars and restaurants; barbershops, salons and other licensed personal service businesses; gyms and fitness centers; and other businesses types located in the "disproportionately impacted area" zip codes of 61603, 61604, 61605, 61606 and 61610.
